

“ZANY DOT BOWL”



1. Dip your sponge into water, squeeze it out, and wipe off your entire plate to remove bisque dust – top, bottom, edges, everywhere.
2. Using a #2 pencil, draw in where you would like your dots- We made sure ours were on a diagonal.
3. Dip your sponge dotter into your water bucket and squeeze it out, leaving it slightly damp.
4. Dip your damp sponge dotter into your paint and sponge on your dots. We used: HOT TAMALE, DANDELION, JADED, CURRY AROUND, GRAPE JELLY, and TOAD-ILY GREEN for ours.
5. Wait for your paint to dry and paint another 2 coats on top of your sponged circle using a PAINT BRUSH!
6. Let each coat dry before you paint the next.
7. Keep track of your coats – and don't go over 3 coats!
8. While waiting for your final coat to dry, flip your piece over and paint 3 coats of HOT TAMALE (or your choice of color) onto the bottom. Wait until your paint is dry before you move onto the next coat.
9. BREAK TIME: While your last coat is drying, enjoy some snacks and treats.
10. Now that you've taken a break, it's time to paint your design on top of your now- dry circles (THE CIRCLES MUST BE 100% DRY BEFORE MOVING ON). Using the squeeze bottles provided, paint your design. We painted multi sized circles and dots on ours.
11. If you're following the sample, we used:
 - on top of JADED: BLUE YONDER and GLO WORM
 - on top of DANDELION: HOT TAMALE and BLUE GRASS
 - on top of CURRY AROUND: BLUE GRASS and ORANGE A PEEL
 - on top of GRAPE JELLY: SUNKISSED and TEAL NEXT TIME
 - on top of TOAD-ILY GREEN: TUTU TANGO and SUNKISSED

*Please feel free to change up the design and color scheme and make the piece yours!

12. Sign your masterpiece with a glaze pencil or paint. Fill out your white tag, and bring it and your piece up to the counter to check out.
